

October 2019 - Milestone

Perini met a major milestone by completing important elements of the project in time for the start of the Fall hockey season. Completed renovations included restrooms, hockey lockers, storage, offices, and other team activity areas, as well as all work above the ice. The mechanical systems supporting the newly renovated facilities were also completed, including the north geothermal wellfield.

Multi-Purpose Arena Sports Camp in Progress

Initial activities included installation of temporary facilities for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, who are managing the project, as well as for multiple USAFA athletic department staffs; hockey, basketball and track. Miscellaneous repairs were conducted in conjunction with the on-going athletic schedule and activities through April 2019. At this point, major activities commenced that included the erection of Quick Deck Platforms over both the Hockey Ice Arena and the Clune Basketball Arena to allow for fire protection measures that include application of intumescent coatings to the exposed steel roof structure and installation of rigid fire board. Careful planning and scheduling was required to

accommodate graduation ceremonies, summer sports camps at each of the three arenas, and early hockey practice that started in August.

September 19, 2018 – Contract Award

Perini Management Services is implementing a newly awarded Tutor Perini contract for repairs to the US Air Force Academy Cadet Field House. The project is the first phase of a planned multi-phase, multi-year restoration project for the 51-year old facility. The scope of this contract includes extensive mechanical repairs primarily located on the participant level and multi-purpose level mechanical rooms of the Fieldhouse. It also includes the installation of a geothermal heating and cooling system under an existing parking lot. The project schedule has been carefully developed to execute work in phases, taking into consideration the various sports seasons, so as to minimize any impacts on athletes and fans.
